

**NEW EQUIPMENT ADDS PLEASURE TO TRANSCONTINENTAL TRAVEL**




A private view of the C.P.R. Trans-Canada train was afforded yesterday. Several innovations in the way of improved equipment are embodied this year. One of the unique advancements is the "solarium" lounge, this car containing a ladies' lounge, gentlemen's smoking and card room, writing alcove, shower baths, and, last but not least, the "solarium," a miniature sunroom on wheels, "Vita-glass" admitting the curing rays of "Old Sol" all the way across Canada. The dining-

car equipment is out of the ordinary, too. Low tables with comfortable chairs accommodate thirty-six patrons at one sitting. The sleeping cars have eight sections, each semi-private; a drawing-room and two compartments, the latter being so arranged that they can be opened into each other if need be. Features of the new equipment are shown above by The Globe photographer. At the upper left is a section of the new diner; at the upper right, the ladies' lounge; below, at the left, the solarium, and, at the lower right, the kitchen of the new dining car.


